Each job seeker must be screened for target group membership on or before the day that you offer the job.</p> <p>The Missouri Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) Program is now offering an online application system for a more efficient means of submitting applications for certification. The application entry process includes entering employee and employer information from the completed and signed IRS Form 8850 and ETA Form 9061.
