The program provides grant funds to businesses to upgrade or improve the job-related skills of their full-time employees. Grant funds may be approved for eligible training provided to existing and new employees in full-time jobs. Any business making a firm commitment to locate a new facility in Wisconsin or expand an existing facility within the state and is upgrading a product, process or service that requires training in new technology and industrial skills is eligible for a Training Grant. Credits can only be claimed in a tax year in which a company increases net employment in Wisconsin when compared to the previous tax year. This program provides the following tax credits: Job Creation: Up to 10% of annual wages paid to eligible employees earning at least 150% of federal minimum wage Job Training: Up to 50% of eligible training costs"	Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation	Tax Credit	
Wisconsin Manufacturing and Agriculture Credit	http://inwisconsin.com/grow/assistance/wisconsin-manufacturing-and-agriculture-credit/	The manufacturing and agriculture tax credit is available to individuals and entities for taxable years that begin on or after January 1, 2013, for manufacturing and agricultural activities in Wisconsin. The tax credit is available for income derived from manufacturing or agricultural property located in Wisconsin and will offset a significant share of Wisconsin income taxes. The credit is a percentage of "eligible qualified production activities income." The credit amounts to 7.5% of "eligible qualified production activities income," resulting in an effective corporate tax rate of 0.4% as of 2016.	Wisconsin Department of Revenue	Tax Credit	N/A
